What is Coordinated Entry?

Coordinated Entry is a process where individuals and families experiencing a housing crisis can access community resources.

Are you experiencing a housing crisis?

Start with Coordinated Entry through One Roof



What can I expect when I speak to Coordinated Entry staff?

- We will listen as you share your current situation
- We will support you in finding safe and appropriate housing options
- We will work through some housing questions with you and discuss immediate safe sleeping options, such as shelter
- We will help connect you to community services (such as food, clothing, and health care)

What can I do to get the most from my experience?

- To best understand your situation and determine housing options for you, mention:
 - where you slept last night
 - how long have you been in your current situation
 - how many people are in your household
 - whether or not you have a disability
- It is encouraged for you to answer questions as honestly as possible

Coordinated Entry CAN

Assess based on your needs

Provide referrals based on services available in your area

Connect you to other community resources such as food, clothing, and healthcare

Assist you in figuring out what housing options are available to you

Coordinated Entry CANNOT

Provide immediate shelter or hotel vouchers

Guarantee eligibility of housing resources

Provide financial assistance

Act as landlords or housing providers
